Hans Wissema (1942) is managing director of Wissema Consulting Ltd, Management Consultants in the Netherlands/Bulgaria, emeritus professor of entrepreneurship and innovation at Delft University of Technology and visiting professor at the University of Rousse, Bulgaria. Educated in chemical engineering and control engineering in the Netherlands and the UK, he joined Akzo Nobel in 1970 where he worked as research coordinator, strategic planner of Akzo International and project manager of international investment projects. He has founded and is or was chairing a number of societies or foundations in private equity, technostarters and SME development in the Netherlands and in Bulgaria and he was a board member of several management societies and management publications, including IEE Transactions on Engineering Management and Long Range Planning. He was made an honorary member of the Amstel Private Equity Club in the Netherlands in 2009.
