GSOM Economy&Management Conference (below – GSOM EMC) has been organized by Graduate School of Management of St. Petersburg University, a recognized leader in Russian business education, accredited by EQUIS, AACSB, and AMBA.

GSOM EMC was first held in 2014 under the title Emerging Markets Conference and since then has become a unique platform for discussing and sharing research ideas and experience in a wide range of topics. Its academic sessions and associated events joined together more than 2500 leading scholars and business practitioners from emerging markets (including Russia, CIS, and CEE countries) and all over the world. The conference encourages and promotes research and creates the dialog between academics and practitioners about current trends in management, business, and economy.

Nowadays, when there is a greater level of economic and political turbulence, firms and public institutions face greater pressure to adjust or transform their strategies. hybrid format in Russian with simultaneous translation and some sections and associated events in hybrid format in Russian. The registration fee for all online participants is waived.
